Invitation to WOLTE15 – 15th Workshop on Low Temperatures Electronics, June 6th–9th, Matera (Italy)

On behalf of the Organizing Committee, we would like to invite you to WOLTE15 the 15th Workshop on Low Temperatures Electronics which will take place on 6–9 June 2022, in Matera, Italy.

WOLTE are biannual workshops which have become important appointments for the scientists from all around the world working in the field of the low-temperature electronics. This year WOLTE15 is organized by the University of Napoli Federico II, University of Salerno, CNR SPIN, INFN, and ASI.

We think that WOLTE will continue its successful series of appointments since the workshop topics were renewed to mirror current scientific developments in the field of cryogenic electronics.

The topics we have identified for WOLTE15 are:

- » Low temperature electronic and magnetic devices
- » Low temperature detectors readouts
- » Hybrids and integrated systems based on low temperature devices for electronic applications
- » Quantum Technologies with low temperature components and systems
- » Integration of low temperature electronics with quantum optics devices
- » Low temperature electronics in space applications (for communications, environmental monitoring, astrophysics)
- » Advances in cryogenic cooling systems for electronics applications
- » New trends in memory devices and neuromorphic computing at low temperatures

This year, due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, the event will be held in hybrid format with both virtual and in-person participation and is expected to attract about 150 participant in total. We believe that this format, with the additional support of the virtual platform which disclosed its potential in the previous WOLTE14 edition, will provide a fruitful opportunity for presenting your company's products, services, and techniques to a highly qualified international audience and for putting together scientists and high-tech companies.

Industrial and technological applications will be hosted in our virtual environment, exploiting the various opportunities given by the new media. The exhibition will be closely integrated with the technical program through four sale pitches inserted in the live part of the conference program. In addition to the visibility given on the conference website, the exhibitors will enjoy a dedicated area in the host platform, which will remain open also after the end of the conference, thus increasing the possibility of contacts beyond the customary span. Moreover, the exhibit's virtual booth visitors' contact list will be made available.

Terms and Conditions

1. Contract

This application, properly executed by applicant (exhibitor) shall upon written acceptance and notification of tabletops assigned by IEEE WOLTE 15 management constitute a valid and binding contract.

2. Assignment of Space

Assignment of space to exhibitors and those making application will be made in the order of date and time received. IEEE WOLTE 15 will continue to receive applications and assign exhibit space, as it remains available, until shortly before the show opening date. In all cases, total tabletop payments must be received prior to show opening. IEEE WOLTE 15 assignment of tabletops is final and shall constitute an acceptance of the exhibitor's offer to occupy space. After assignment, space location may not be changed, transferred or canceled by the exhibitor except upon written request and with the subsequent written approval of IEEE WOLTE 15 management. IEEE WOLTE 15 management reserves the right to reassign exhibitor space in order to modify floor plan for overall benefit of the show.

3. Subletting Space

No exhibitor will assign, sublet, or apportion the whole or any part of the space allotted to them, nor exhibit therein, nor permit any other person or party to exhibit therein, any other goods, apparatus, etc. not manufactured or distributed by the exhibitor in the regular course of his business except upon prior written consent of IEEE WOLTE 15 management.

5. Payment Requirements and Cancellation Charges

Applications require full payment before tabletops are assigned. Payment in full is required with submission of contract application or on the date indicated on the invoice. All cancellations must be made in writing.

Before April 6, 2022:

Refund of 50% of the total license fee for cancellation

On or after May 6, 2022:

No refund or credit at any time.

It is understood that IEEE WOLTE 15 reserves the right, at its option, to reassign a canceled tabletop regardless of the cancellation rate assessed. In the event that the premises in which the IEEE WOLTE 15 show is conducted shall become, in the sole discretion of IEEE WOLTE 15, unfit for occupancy, or substantially interfered with by reason of any cause or causes not reasonably within the control of IEEE WOLTE 15, this agreement may be terminated by IEEE WOLTE 15. For this purpose, the term "cause or causes" shall include, but not by way of limitation, fire, flood, epidemic, earthquake, explosion or accident, blockage, embargo, inclement weather, governmental restraints or orders of civil defense, or military

authorities, act of public enemy, riot or civil disturbance, strike, lockout, boycott or other labor disturbance, inability to secure sufficient labor, technical, or other personnel, failure, impairment or lack of adequate transportation facilities, inability to obtain, or condemnation, requisition or commandeering of necessary supplies or equipment, local, state or federal law, ordinance, rule, order, decree or regulation, whether legislative, executive, or judicial, and whether constitutional, or act of god. Should IEEE WOLTE 15 terminate this agreement pursuant to the provision of this paragraph the exhibitor waives any and all claims for damages and agrees that IEEE WOLTE 15 may, after computing the total amount of IEEE WOLTE 15 cost and expenses in connection with its preparation for and conducting of the IEEE WOLTE 15 event, (including a reasonable reserve for claims and other contingencies), refund to the exhibitor, as and for complete settlement and discharge of all said exhibitor's claims and demands, and amount which bears the same relationship to the fee paid by said exhibitor as the total refundable amount as computed above bears to the total amount of fees paid by all exhibitors.

6. Exhibit Tabletop Manning and Dismantling Schedule

A representative must man exhibit space during all times when exhibition is officially open. Exhibit space must be maintained in a neat and orderly manner throughout the exhibition. Exhibitors may begin dismantling only after hours stated in exhibitor service manual. Exhibitors are responsible for removal of all materials used in their display. Any exhibitor leaving materials after hours stated in exhibitor service manual will be charged for the materials' removal.

7. Losses or Damage

Exhibitor agrees that IEEE WOLTE 15 shall not be liable for any damage or liability of any kind or for any loss, damage or injury to persons or property during the term of this agreement, from any cause whatsoever by reason of use, occupation and enjoyment of exhibit space by exhibitor or any person thereon with the consent of exhibitor, and that exhibitor will defend, indemnify and save harmless, IEEE WOLTE 15 from all liability whatsoever, on account of any such damage, or injury, whether or not caused by negligence of or breach of an obligation by exhibitor or its employees or representatives. Exhibitor will be liable for all damages, or liability of any kind or for any loss, damage or injury to persons or any property during the show from any cause whatsoever by reason of use, occupation and enjoyment of exhibit space.



Terms and Conditions (continued)

8. Demonstrations

No demonstrations or solicitations shall be permitted outside of the exhibitor's assigned space, and no signs or placards may be displayed on persons or otherwise outside exhibit spaces.

9. Compliance

The exhibitor assumes all responsibility for compliance with all pertinent ordinances, regulations and codes of duly authorized local, state and federal governing bodies concerning fire, safety and health, together with the rules and regulations of the operators and/or owners of the property wherein the show is held.

10. Policy

It is further agreed that the exhibitor will abide by and comply with rules and regulations concerning local customs that may apply, having agreements with the show Facility or with authorized contractors employed by IEEE WOLTE 15.

11. Management

The exhibitor further agrees that the conditions, rules and regulations of the IEEE WOLTE 15 management are made a part of this contract and that said exhibitor agrees to be bound by each and all of these rules and regulations, and that the management shall have the full power to interpret, amend and enforce all rules and regulations in the best interest of the show.
